

Meeting Halls and Spaces

*** all of Pioneer's meeting halls are handicap accessible.

Hickman Hall: Hickman Hall is Pioneer's largest meeting hall. This hall has a capacity of 225 and overlooks Lake Erie. The upper level is carpeted and can be divided into four large rooms. The lower level has a fireplace, stage, and kitchen facilities. Just outside Hickman Hall is the Pohlman waterfront deck which has the greatest view of Lake Erie.



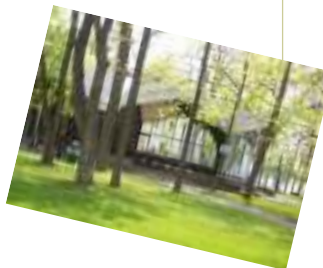
Dallman Hall: This hall is another of Pioneer's large meeting halls. Dallman Hall is located close to all housing options. It also has a capacity of 225. Upper Dallman is a large meeting room with a fireplace. Lower Dallman has a commercial kitchen, dining area, fireplace, and game room complete with air hockey, ping pong, and pool tables.



Karkau Lodge: This hall is a cozy carpeted meeting area for smaller groups. Karkau Lodge features a wood stove, heat air conditioning, and a kitchen. Couches or tables and chairs can be used in this setting. Maximum capacity is approx 25.



Wendt Shelter: This octagon-shaped shelter is partially enclosed, helping to keep it comfortable in windy or rainy weather. The shelter overlooks the lake, contains fully accessible bathrooms with showers, and is adjacent to playground equipment which makes it ideal for picnics big or small.



Chapel of the Woods: Overlooking Lake Erie is our outdoor worship area called the Chapel of the Woods. Benches provide seating and a stone altar and cross serve as a focal point. This space is most commonly used for worship and for wed-

Dining Halls

Pohlman Hall: This dining hall is the bigger of our two dining options. This hall is typically set up with rectangular tables seating 6-8 people per table. Maximum capacity is approximately 144 people.



Schultz Hall: Schultz Hall is a slightly smaller dining area. This hall is typically set up with round tables and seats 6-8 people per table. The maximum capacity of this hall is approximately 80 people.

***Both dining halls are located adjacent to our fully staffed and equipped kitchen. The kitchens located in the meeting halls are also available if your group would like to do their own cooking.



Housing/Cabins



Founders Court: Each cabin has a full bathroom including shower, two twin beds, and a connecting door to the next cabin. Minimum occupancy - 1 person. Maximum occupancy 2-4 people

Refurbished Founders Court: Each cabin sleeps up to four people. Cabins are carpeted and feature a queen size bed, a futon that converts to a double bed or a set of bunk beds, table, chairs, and a private bathroom with shower. Minimum occupancy - 2 people. Maximum occupancy - 4 people.

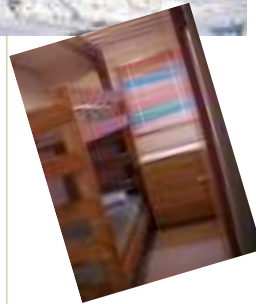
Refurbished Family Court: Incredibly, each cabin sleeps six people, which is wonderful for larger families. A bunkroom sleeps four and a second room sleeps two in a double bed. Other amenities include a dresser, a nightstand, table and chairs, closet, and a private bathroom with shower. Also available are cabins with one queen bed and private bath with shower or cabins with two sets of bunks and a private bath with shower. Minimum occupancy depends on room set up: 1-3 people. Maximum occupancy - 2-4 people.



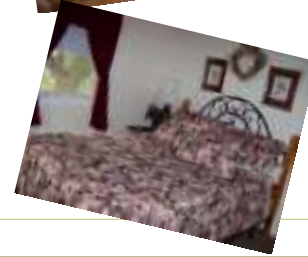
Oldsen Speakers Cabin: Available year round, this heated cabin features two bedrooms; one with a double bed and one with two twin beds and sleeps up to four people. This cabin also features a living room with two couches, an under the counter refrigerator and a private bathroom with shower. Minimum occupancy - 2 people. Maximum occupancy - 4 people




Schroeter Circle: These are year-round winterized cabins. Each cabin has six bedrooms, and can accommodate 20 people. Four bedrooms have two twin bunk beds, and two bedrooms have one bunk bed. Each cabin has two full bathrooms including showers. A common room with tables and chairs is in the front room of the cabin. Minimum occupancy - 10 people per cabin. Maximum occupancy - 20 people per cabin.



Woodland Cottages: Our newest cabins, these year-round bungalows can house up to eight people with a queen bed, a bunkroom that sleeps four, and pull-out sofas in the living room. These cottages also have a full bathroom with large tub and shower and a full kitchen with stove, oven, microwave, refrigerator, coffee maker, and all dishes and cookware. Guests can eat at countertop bar or dining room table. All cottages have both heat and air conditioning as well as a wonderful porch to relax on. Each cabin sleeps 6




Outdoor Facilities



Heuer Woods: Pioneer's Heuer Woods is home to many trails as well as our **Low Ropes Challenge Course**. This course is used by churches, businesses, schools, and community organizations, with leadership from Pioneer facilitators, to improve communication, build trust, and teach and instill teamwork within each group.

Recreation Fields: Do you need a place to play? Pioneer has a full baseball diamond with bleachers, soccer field, volleyball courts, tennis, basketball, and even a mud pit. There are also many large open areas that can be used for many games and activities.

Patios, Porches, and Campfire pits: Pioneer has a number of patios and screened in porches that can be used by small groups or as a place to relax. Finish the day with a campfire in one of our lakefront fire pits or even on the beach.



Waterfront: Pioneer has nearly 1/4 mile of waterfront on Lake Erie's shore. Swimming, boating, and making sand castles are just a few of our favorite things to do on the beach.
